

COVID-19 Policy

With the current Covid-19 situation, we at *Napoleon Livestock* are doing our part to help control the dangers we face. We and Michigan Department of Agriculture also realize the importance of Auction Marketing in our state. We will continue to provide marketing of your livestock and hay but will temporarily have the following guidelines to protect you as consignors and buyers:

Unloading Livestock: If you desire, you may remain in your vehicle and our staff will unload your livestock for you. If you want to unload yourself as usual, we ask that you keep a safe distance from others.

Picking up checks: We offer to bring your check to your vehicle if you desire. Just call the office and we will bring your check out to you. All checks not picked up sale day will be mailed Tuesday as usual. If you come into the office, please keep a safe distance from others.

Viewing the Auction: As the Governor and the Center for Disease Control have called for no gatherings of more than 50 people, we ask that the inside Arena be for active buyers and consignors only. Please seat yourself the recommended distance from others. We realize that attending the auction for some people is a social event, but please do your part.

Viewing the Hay Auction: If you are considering buying hay, please keep the recommended distance from others. We ask that spectators remain in their vehicles.

Paying for purchases: When paying in the office, please keep the recommended distance from others. If you desire, you may remain in your vehicle, call our office, and we will bring your receipt to you and collect payment.

We are uncomfortable having to temporarily change the way we do business, but also realize the importance of providing marketing services to you as customers.
